NCPA's annual scramble golf tournament is scheduled for **SUNDAY, MAY 3**, with an 11:00 a.m. shotgun start at The East Course of The Broadmoor, right on the grounds of the hotel.

The East Course has been home to many major tournaments, including the 1959 U.S. Amateur (which was Jack Nicklaus' first major win), the 1967 U.S. Amateur, and the 1995 U.S. Women's Open, which was Annika Sorenstam's first major title. Most recently, the famous course served as the host to the 2008 U.S. Senior Open and the 2011 U. S. Women's Open Championship.

The fee for the tournament is \$225 per player, which includes green fees, cart & range balls. You should make arrangements for your own rental clubs.
